

PUBLIC AGREEMENT
on the Procedure for Publishing Authors' Articles in the Journal
"Philosophy, Economics and Law Review"

Article 1. Scope and Purpose

1. This Public Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the Agreement) establishes the procedure for publishing authors' articles in the journal "Philosophy, Economics and Law Review".
2. The Agreement is addressed to an indefinite number of persons and applies to all authors who agree to its terms.

Article 2. Public Offer and Access to Terms

1. The Agreement constitutes a public offer in accordance with Article 633 of the Civil Code of Ukraine.

The publication of this Agreement on the journal's official website is an offer to conclude the Agreement on the terms set forth.

Article 3. Parties and Their Roles

1. Author — a natural person who created the article and submits it to the Editorial Office; within the scope of this Agreement, the Author is the Licensor.
2. Publisher/Editorial Office — the organisation responsible for processing and publishing the materials; within the scope of this Agreement, the Publisher is the Licensee.

Article 4. Procedure for Accession (Acceptance)

1. The Agreement is concluded by the Author's full and unconditional acceptance of its terms, without any conditions, exclusions, or reservations (Article 642 of the Civil Code of Ukraine).
2. Prior to acceptance, the content of the article is agreed upon between the Author and the Editorial Office.
3. The acceptance event: the Author's submission of materials for publication in the Licensee's editions.

Article 5. Licence Terms and Scope of Rights

1. The Author retains personal non-property and property copyright to their work.
2. The Author grants the Publisher the right of first publication under the terms of the [Creative Commons Attribution International](#) (CC BY) licence.

Under this licence, the Licensee has the right to:

- a) publish articles in English and distribute their printed versions;
- b) translate articles into English (for articles originally in Ukrainian) and distribute the printed version of the translation;
- c) distribute electronic versions of the articles, as well as the electronic versions of English translations (for articles originally in Ukrainian) via any electronic means (official website, electronic databases, repositories, etc.).

Article 6. Confirmation of Acceptance and Rights Distribution

1. The fact of accepting the terms of the Agreement is the submission of materials by the Author to the Editorial Office for publication.
2. Confirmation of the rights distribution between the Licensor and Licensee is the publication of the Author's material in the journal "Philosophy, Economics and Law Review".

Article 7. Liability of the Parties

1. In case of non-performance or improper performance of obligations, the Parties are liable in accordance with the applicable laws of Ukraine.
2. Nothing in this Agreement limits the Parties' rights to protect their interests in accordance with the law.

Article 8. Dispute Resolution Procedure

1. Disputes and disagreements arising in connection with the performance of this Agreement shall be resolved through negotiations between the Parties.
2. If no agreement is reached, the dispute shall be resolved in court in accordance with the laws of Ukraine.

Article 9. Final Provisions

1. In fulfilling the terms of this Agreement, the Parties shall comply with the laws of Ukraine in all matters not expressly regulated herein.
2. Any updates to the Agreement apply from the moment of their publication at the address specified in Article 2, paragraph 2.

3. The Agreement becomes effective for a specific Author from the moment of acceptance, as defined in Article 4, paragraph 3.
